# **Fox Class Descriptions**:

<u>Lead Line Equitation:</u> For earliest beginner riders — to be shown at walk on lead line. All riders receive Blue Ribbon and a special prize! May cross-enter Pre-Beginner.

<u>Pre-Beginner Division</u>: For early beginner riders. Coaches/handlers permitted in ring for safety if needed; however excessive coaching may be penalized. May cross enter Lead Line or Novice Walk/Trot.

<u>Beginner Walk/Trot</u>: For riders in 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> year of showing (not counting Pre-Beginner). May also enter Novice Walk/trot, Beginner Medal, Challenges, Classics, & Beginner Crossrails.

Novice Walk/Trot: Rider not to have won more than 3 Fox blue ribbons (excluding Pre-Beginner ribbons).

Adult Walk/Trot: For amateur adults on a horse or pony – rider may not cross-enter higher than crossrails.

Beginner Crossrail EQ: Riders in 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> year of showing over fences. Trotting courses encouraged. Simple changes permitted – outside 4 jumps only. May cross enter Beginner W/T Division or Hunter Crossrails and associated classics/medals.

<u>Crossrail Hunter (Green Rider):</u> For inexperienced riders. Simple lead changes not to be penalized. Riders may crossenter either Beginner Crossrails or Mini Hunter/EQ 18" verticals.

<u>Open Crossrail Hunter:</u> Open to all horses, ponies, & riders. Simple leads not to be penalized. TIP entries must have a Jockey Club TIP Number to enter. Horses may not cross-enter divisions higher than 2' at the same show.

<u>Mini EQ 18" & Pre-Green EQ 21" Verticals:</u> For inexperienced riders. Simple lead changes not to be penalized. Mini EQ may cross enter Mini Hunter, and either Crossrail Hunter <u>or</u> Pre-Green/Hopeful Hunter 21" Verticals / Pre-Green EQ. Pre-Green EQ 21" may cross enter Pre-Green/Hopeful Hunter and either Mini Hunter/EQ 18" or 2' classes.

<u>Mini Hunter 18" & Hopeful Hunter 21" Verticals:</u> Open to all horses & ponies. Simple lead changes not to be penalized. Mini Hunter Horse/Rider Combination may cross enter Mini EQ, & Crossrail Hunter <u>or</u> Pre-Green EQ/Hopeful Hunter 21" Verticals. Hopeful Hunter Horse/rider combination may cross enter Pre-Green EQ (if eligible) and either Mini Hunter/EQ 18" or 2' classes.

**Fox Schooling Hunter 2' or 2'6"**: Open to all horses, ponies, riders.

Baby Green Hunter 2': Open to all horses, ponies, & riders – horse may not jump higher than 2'.

<u>Low Child/Adult Hunter & EQ 2'</u>: Open to Adult Amateur & Junior Riders - may either cross enter 21" Verticals <u>or</u> classes no higher than 2'3".

All Day Hunter Warm-ups: Open to all; may be ridden anytime as needed.

<u>All Day Jumper Warm-up</u>: May be ridden at any height. Please tell gate-keeper it's a warm-up trip when you check in. <u>Progressive Jumper Division:</u> Open to all horses/riders. Week-end & Year-end Highpoint Division (May not jump higher than .90m in same show weekend)

<u>Pre-Child/Adult Amateur Jumper Division:</u> Open to horses or ponies/ridden by a youth or adult amateur rider. Weekend & Year-end Highpoint Division (May not jump higher than .80m in same show weekend.)

<u>Open Model Hunter in Hand:</u> Open to all horses/ponies & riders. Will exhibit in hand – will be asked to walk and trot in hand, and present & line up for the judge

USEF Table II.2c - Power/Speed; Clear Preliminary round continues on to timed speed phase.

<u>USEF Table II.2.1</u> - Speed Round; Fastest round with least amount of faults.

USEF Table IV Section I - Optimum Time; An Optimum Time is posted by the Course Designer,

which is defined as 4 seconds less than posted Time Allowed. If upon completing the course, there is a tie in faults, (or lack of faults), the horse with the time closest to the Optimum Time (over or under) is the winner.

<u>Equitation Challenge Classes:</u> Fox Beginner Challenge in Hunter 4 (Saturday only) shows at walk & trot, with optional testing by judge. Fox Equitation Challenge in Hunter 1 (Saturday only) receives Neck Sashes for Champions & Reserve – no membership is required! <u>Fox under Saddle Challenge:</u> Open to all horses & ponies; judged on quality of movement, consistency & suitability as a hunter; To be shown at walk, trot, canter, lengthening of trot, hand gallop, halt, etc. This class takes place on Sunday in Hunter 1. No membership is required.



<u>Eligibility</u>: You may obtain a TIP number for your thoroughbred by going to: <u>tictip@jockeyclub.com</u>. A Jockey Club Registration number, (may be from foreign TB registry), a verified Lip Tattoo, a 5 generation pedigree, or a letter of verification from Jockey Club is required. There is no charge for a TIP number.

### **Stabling & Schooling**

Horse Stalls will be available Friday at 10:00 a.m. Ticketed warm-up Friday from 12:30 – 6:30 p.m. The stadium will close for warm-up at 6:00, in order for the Friday evening festivities to begin. A certified medic will be on site. Number of riders schooling should be limited to 8 (per show ring) at one time. PLEASE warm-up on flat in the regular warm-up rings first, (& jump in the show rings). Ring Monitors will be present to insure that warm ups are conducted in a safe and courteous manner. Exhibitors may hack (only) in show rings on mornings before show.

# **Shavings**

Horse park regulations state that all horse stalls have a minimum of 2 bags of shavings. You may bring your own, or order shavings from Queen Sales (770) 860-9111. Golf carts may also be rented thru Queen Sales. (To insure availability of golf cart, please call by Monday morning prior to show.)

<u>Directions to GA International Horse Park:</u> From I-20 take exit #82. At end of ramp go north on Hwy. #138 approximately 4 miles. Turn right onto Centennial Olympic Parkway. Main entrance is 2 miles ahead on right.

# **General Rules**

- \* H. J. Fox Classics, their employees & officials shall not be responsible for any accident or injury which might occur to persons, horses or any property while at the show, nor will they be responsible for any personal articles lost, stolen or destroyed.
  - \* Schooling over Show Fences permitted only during designated time (Friday from 12:30 6:30 p.m.).
- \*Horses and Ponies may enter no more than 7 classes over fences in a single show day, including equitation, warm-ups, & all special classes (such as classics). NEW!!! A horse or pony may not enter more than 5 jumper classes. ALL jumper classics, stakes, warm-ups, & clear round classes shall count toward the limit of 5 classes per show day.
  - \* Management may restrict the courtesy circle with a mandatory dotted line.
  - \* A 3 minute gate call may be put into effect at any time upon announcement.

Flat Classes will not be held for trainer conflicts. Please check with gate keepers often, & advise of possible conflicts.

- \* Proper attire is required in all classes except warm-ups, when chaps or other non-standard attire may be worn.

  Martingales are not permitted in flat classes. Running martingales are allowed in Jumper Ring.
  - \* Helmets must be worn while mounted at all times. All riders must wear ASTM-SEI approved helmets with a properly-adjusted (snug) harness.
- \* All dogs must be on a leash no more than 6 feet long, or otherwise contained, at all times while on competition grounds. Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from their dogs' behaviors. Owners of loose and/or disruptive dogs may be subject to penalties and/or fines.
- \* Unlicensed drivers are not permitted to operate motorized vehicle of any kind including (but not limited to) golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds.
  - \* Questions not covered by GHJA rules will be decided by show management; their decisions will be final.
- \* Any verbal or physical act of discourtesy toward a judge, show official, show staff or Horse Park staff member on the part of a trainer, owner, rider, groom, family member or person associated with an entry will immediately disqualify that entry, and all fees will be forfeited.
  - \*A current Negative Coggins is required to be on the show grounds.
  - \* Adds & scratches MUST be made in Show Office, with Add/Scratch slips presented to appropriate gate.

    Taking ticket to relevant gate is mandatory to remove a class from your bill.
    - \* Poling & offsets are forbidden anywhere on the show grounds.
  - \* In order to compete in pony classes, GHJA or USEF measurement cards must be presented to the show office. A GHJA steward will be available Saturday & Sunday if you need to have a pony measured.
  - \* NEW! An Adult Amateur rider may compete on a pony in any class showing at the specified horse fence height.

    Said pony may not cross enter into any Pony Hunter division or Junior Age Group Equitation

    division or Junior Medal class at the same show.
    - \* The Class Schedule may be changed for the betterment of the show. Exhibitors agree to show under a substitute judge should a legitimate need arise.
      - \* Parents or guardians shall hold management, staff & officials harmless for any injury to minor show participants, staff, or spectators.
    - \* NEW! Low Child/Adult Jumpers .85m may not show higher than .90m at the same horse show. High Child/Adult Jumpers .95m may not show higher than 1.10m at the same horse show.

The October shows are Local Member GHJA shows, & part of the 6 weekend 2019 H. J. Fox Classics Series. Each person who participates in these shows is responsible for knowledge of & is subject to GHJA & H. J. Fox rules. The following divisions are recognized by both H. J. Fox & GHJA. Points won will count toward daily and year-end awards.

# **Hunter Divisions: (GHJA & Fox)**

**Open Hunter** Open to all horses or ponies ridden by juniors, amateurs or professionals. Fence height 2'6" or 3'. Rider may show at either height.

**Adult Amateur Hunter** Open to Adult Amateur riders on horses or ponies. A pony ridden in the Adult Amateur Hunters may not cross enter into any Pony Hunter division or Junior Equitation classes or Junior Medal at the same show. Fence height 3'. (Horse/rider combo MAY NOT cross enter Pre-Adult!)

**Children's Hunter** Open to all horses ridden by a Junior. Fence height 3'. (Horse/rider combo MAY NOT cross enter Pre-Child!) **Pre-Adult Hunter** Open to Adult Amateur riders on horse or ponies; horse/rider combination may not have competed at 3'3" or higher at Local or Regular Member shows in the previous 3 years. Fence height 2'6". (Horse/rider combo MAY NOT cross enter into Adult Hunter 3'.)

**Pre-Children's Hunter** Open to Junior riders on horses or ponies; horse/rider combination may not have competed at 3'3" or higher at Local or Regular Member shows in previous 3 years. Fence height 2'6". (Horse/rider combo MAY NOT cross enter into Children's Hunter 3'.)

Modified Hunter Open to all horses or ponies ridden by juniors, amateurs or professionals. Fence height 2'9".

**Schooling Pony** Open to Junior riders on ponies. Fence height 2' or 2'6". May jump either height.

Small Pony Hunter Open to Junior riders 12 years of age or under on ponies not to exceed 12.2 hh. Fence height 2'.

**Medium Pony Hunter** Open to Junior riders 14 years of age or under on ponies over 12.2 hh, but not to exceed 13.2 hh. Fence height 2'3".

Large Pony Hunter Open to Junior riders on ponies not to exceed 14.2 hh. Fence height 2'9".

**Short Stirrup Hunter** Open to riders 12 years & under on horses or ponies in their first or second year of showing over fences higher than 18" in any hunter show. Note: Participation in once around/twice around & cross rail classes will not count as part of 2 years as long as jump height does not exceed 18". A rider on a pony may cross-enter only into Schooling Pony (2' or 2'6") & age group equitation. A rider on a pony may not enter Open Hunter, even at the 2'6" height, nor any other unrated classes that exceed 2'6". A rider on a horse may cross-enter only into Pre-Children's Hunter & age group equitation, not to include GHJA medals. Riders may enter non-recognized classes where fence heights do not exceed 2'6, including non-rated medals. Riders may show in Short Stirrup classes for two consecutive years. Year will begin Dec. 1<sup>st</sup> & end Nov. 30<sup>th</sup>. Fence height 2'. See current GHJA Rule Book for further clarification regarding eligibility.

**Long Stirrup Hunter** Open to Amateur & Junior riders, 13 years of age & older, in their first or second year of showing on ponies or horses over fences higher than 18" in any hunter show. Participation in once around-twice around & crossrail classes will not count as part of 2 years as long as jump height does not exceed 18". Adult riders re-entering show ring after an absence cannot have shown over fences higher than 2'6" in past 5 years. A rider may cross enter only Hunter divisions & age group equitation at same show if fence height does not exceed 2'6", not to include GHJA medals, or Open Hunter (even at 2'6" height). A rider on a pony may not cross-enter into Pony Hunter, GHJA Pony Medal, Open Hunter, or any non-recognized classes that exceed 2'6" in height. Riders may enter non-recognized classes where fence heights do not exceed 2'6", including non-rated medals. Riders may not enter "under saddle" or "flat" classes that do not fall within these parameters. Riders may show in Long Stirrup classes for two consecutive years. Year begins Dec. 1st & ends Nov. 30th. Fence height 2'3". See current GHJA Rule Book for further clarification.

The Hunter Divisions above will receive Championship Awards each show day, & also Yearend Points for GHJA & Fox.

# **Equitation**

**Short Stirrup Equitation** Open to qualified Short Stirrup riders. Fence height 2'.

Long Stirrup Equitation Open to qualified Long Stirrup riders. Fence height 2'3".

**Equitation 11 & under** Open to Jrs. whose 11<sup>th</sup> birthday wasn't before Dec. 1, 2018. Fence height 2'. No straight lines less than 60'.

**Equitation 12-14** Open to Juniors whose 14<sup>th</sup> birthday wasn't before Dec. 1, 2018. Fence height 2'6". No straight lines less than 60'.

Equitation 15-17 Open to Juniors whose 17<sup>th</sup> birthday was not before Dec. 1, 2018. Fence height 3'

**Adult Equitation** Open to Adult Amateurs. Fence height 3'

The above listed Equitation Divisions will receive daily & year-end Championship Award Points for H. J. Fox.

# **Jumper Divisions (GHJA & Fox)**

.80 m (2'7") Open to all riders on horses or ponies.

**Low Child/Adult Jumper .85m (2'9")** Open to Jr. or Amt. riders on horses or ponies. Horse/rider may not cross enter into classes higher than .90m at the same show.

.90 m (2'II") Open to all riders on horses or ponies.

**Child/Adult Jumper .95 m (3'1")** Open to Junior & Amateur riders on horses or ponies. Horse/rider may not cross enter into classes higher than 1.10m at the same show.

1m (3'3") Open to all riders on horses or ponies.

**1.10 m (3'7") Jumper** Open to all riders on horses or ponies.

These Jumper Divisions will receive Championship Awards for the weekend, and also Yearend Points for GHJA & Fox.

**Hunter over Fences** classes to o be shown over at least 8 fences at required height. To be judged on performance & soundness unless otherwise stated. **Hunter under Saddle** to be shown at walk, trot & canter. Light contact with horse's mouth is required. (Martingales not permitted). Hunter courses will simulate fences found in the hunt field such as brush, wall, in & out, oxer, post & rails, gate, bank, coop & panels. Divisions with less than 3 entries may be combined. Pony must possess & present to office a GHJA or USEF measurement card to compete in any Pony Hunter division. **All courses, horse & pony, are set on a 12' stride** 

### Points, Prizes & Cash Awards

Classes require a minimum of 3 entries for points to count, or to make a division. Classes offering prize money of \$500 (or more) must have 10 entries to award full cash amount. If less than 10 but minimum of 5, the respective entry fee will be reduced, with class becoming an add-back. A portion of entry fees & added money will be distributed among top placings. If class has minimum of 3 (but less than 5), the entry fee will be reduced, & no cash will be awarded. Normal ribbons and prizes will then apply. Entries in Hunter Derby, Mini Prix or other cash award classes must enter minimum of one other class besides the "money" class. (\$300 Jumper Classes only require 5 entries to receive full payback of \$120, \$75, \$60, \$30, \$15.)

# Champion & Reserve Awards for 35+ Divisions Daily!

10 points for first place; 6 points for second place; 4 points for third place; 2 points for fourth place; 1 point for fifth place; 5 points for sixth place

In case of a tie for Champion or Reserve Champion, award goes to rider with most points over fences. Points for year-end awards will accumulate from riders' date of membership. Each Champion & Reserve Champion will receive special ribbons. Champions also are allowed to choose a prize from the Awards Table in the Show Office.

### **GHJA Medal Classes**

**Specifications for GHJA Medals:** Must be GHJA Member to compete in GHJA Medal classes. To be shown over modified jumper-type course of at least 8 fences. Course must include at least 1 oxer & 1 change of direction. To be judged on seat, hands, guidance, & control of horse. Minimum of 6 riders, if available, required to show on flat. Flat portion of selected riders counts 25%. Three entries must compete both phases for points to count. In lieu of a flat phase, management has option of placing 2 tests from USEF 1-9. Judge may require riders to perform any USEF test 1-19.

**GHJA Pony Medal:** Ponies with measurement cards ridden by Junior riders. Small ponies to be ridden by Junior riders 12 years of age or under to be jumped at 2'. Medium ponies to be ridden by Junior riders 14 years of age or under to be jumped at 2'3". Large ponies to be ridden by Juniors to be jumped at 2'9".

J.D. Pounds Junior Medal: Open to Juniors on horses. Fence height 3'.

Laura Tison Adult Amateur Medal: Open to Adult Amateurs on horse or pony. Fence height 3'.

GHJA Medals can be combined if there are less than three in any of the three medals. However rider/horse must jump at appropriate fence height. NEW: Management has the option of placing 2 tests from USEF 1-9 into the jumping phase in lieu of the 25% flat phase.

# **EQUITATION CHALLENGE CLASS SPECS – HUNTER 1**

### FOX (Saturday only – No membership required). GHJA (Sunday only – must be a current GHJA member)

Open to all Junior & Adult Amateur <u>GHJA members</u> on horses or ponies, to be judged at walk, trot & canter. Will be asked to perform minimum of 2 of following USEF tests to be chosen by judge:

- 1) Halt (4-6 seconds) or Halt & Back 2) Hand Gallop 9) Ride without stirrups
  - 15) Change leads on a line demonstrating simple or flying change of lead
  - 17) Canter on counter lead (maximum of 12 horses at one time)

Martingales are not permitted. Riders receiving outside assistance or coaching while in arena will be eliminated. (For GHJA Challenge ONLY: All riders who have won the GHJA FINALS Equitation Challenge in the past 3 years may not compete.)


